GENERAL AUCTION RULES

- Participation in the auction constitutes acceptance by the bidder of all rules and conditions as set out in this document.
- All rules apply to the silent auctions and Live Auction.
- The Vancouver International Wine Festival (VIWF) and Bard on the Beach Shakespeare Festival (Bard), in presenting this auction, make every effort to properly describe all auction items. All items are sold "as is", and the VIWF and Bard neither warrant, not represent, and shall in no event be responsible for the correctness of the description, genuineness, authorship, provenance, value or condition of the property. No statement contained in the description of the auction items or made orally at the auction or elsewhere shall be deemed to be warranty, representation or assumption of liability. Neither the LCLB nor LDB is responsible for the quality of the auctioned wine or liquor.
- Bottles are available for in-hand inspection to potential bidders, and each bidder should satisfy him/herself about the conditions prior to bidding.
- The VIWF and Bard reserve the right to withdraw any auction item.
- In case of discrepancy between the items on display or actual gift certificate and the catalogue description, the display item or gift certificate shall be deemed the valid description for bidding purposes.
- Exact size of wine items may not be as stated in the catalogue.
- In the event of a dispute involving an auction item, the decision of the Gala Manager, or designate, will be final.
- In the event of a tie at the One Bid Auction, a draw will be made of the two bids to determine the successful bidder.
- Each bid will specify the item's value, minimum dollar increment, reserve or guaranteed bid
 where applicable. The minimum bid amount will be indicated on the first line of the bid
 sheet. All starting bids must either match the minimum bid amount or be higher, by at least
 the minimum dollar increment. All subsequent bids must be higher than the preceding bid by
 at least the minimum bid amount. Bids with incorrect increments will be disqualified.
- Winning bids will be available approximately 20 minutes after close of the auction at the cashier's desk in the Boardroom.
- All sales are final. There will be no exchange or refund on items by the VIWF, Bard, or the donor.
- Payment in full must be made the night of the auction regardless of when the wine is picked up.
- BC law requires that a 10% Provincial Sales tax will be added to all successful bids for wine and other alcohol.
- A cashier's receipt must be presented before the pick up and removal of any purchased item.
- All items that are purchased must be either: a) picked up from the Ballroom and taken home this evening, or b) picked up from the Boardroom at the Fairmont Hotel Vancouver tomorrow between 10:00 am and 12:00 pm, in order to avoid additional fees.
- Any wine items that are purchased and not picked up as noted immediately above may be subject to a \$25 handling fee per lot. All such items will be transferred to the custody of 13C Wine Storage (13C) and will be available for pick-up by making arrangements with 13C (tel 604 558 1355). VIWF will have no further responsibility or liability for all such transferred items.
- Any wine items that are not picked up from 13C by March 15, 2018 will be subject to the normal storage charges levied by 13C as well as their normal terms and conditions for storage. All such wine items will not be released until full payment of the handling fee and storage charges, if applicable, is made. It is the responsibility of the successful bidder to contact 13C to arrange for pick-up of wine items and/or for payment of any applicable storage charges.
- All service items must be used within the period stated, or from one year of the auction date, February 24, 2018.
- BC law prohibits the consumption of wine items that are purchased in the auction at this evening's event.







1983 DOMAINE DE LA ROMANÉE CONTI "LA TÂCHE"Value: \$8,000One 750 ml bottle.Value: \$8,000

The Domaine de la Romanée-Conti is the most celebrated and legendary wine producer in the world. At the top of the hierarchy of the great wines produced here sits the monopole, Romanée-Conti itself. Second in line — and often only a shade behind in quality — Is La Tâche, a small grand cru vineyard in the village of Vosne-Romanée, at the heart of Burgundy's Côte de Nuits. It covers 6 hectares (15 acres) of land planted to Pinot Noir and is also a monopole of the iconic Domaine de la Romanée-Conti. The single wine made from the La Tâche vines is full-bodied and structured, and is one of the most expensive and sought-after wines in the world. Clive Coates MW wrote in his tasting note of the 1983 La Tâche that the wine is: "Exotic and lovely...Long and multidimensional. A really splendid example." Coates rated this wine 18.5/20 and suggested drinking the wine "Now to 2022".

Le Musigny is a revered Grand Cru vineyard site right at the heart of Burgundy's Côte de Nuits wine district in the parish of Chambolle-Musigny. The vineyard has long played an important part in local life – so much so that, in 1882, its name was appended to that of the village, which was originally just Chambolle. The vineyard was officially classified as a Grand Cru in 1936. Musigny's hallmark is its amazing balance between power and finesse. Michael Broadbent MW tasted this exact Coron bottling of 1964 de Vogue Musigny in March of 2002, noting that the wine showed: "Medium-deep; fairly high-toned 'boiled beetroot' Pinot, this time noting a strawberry-like development; dry, stern, fair body...a touch of tartness but delicious flavour."
